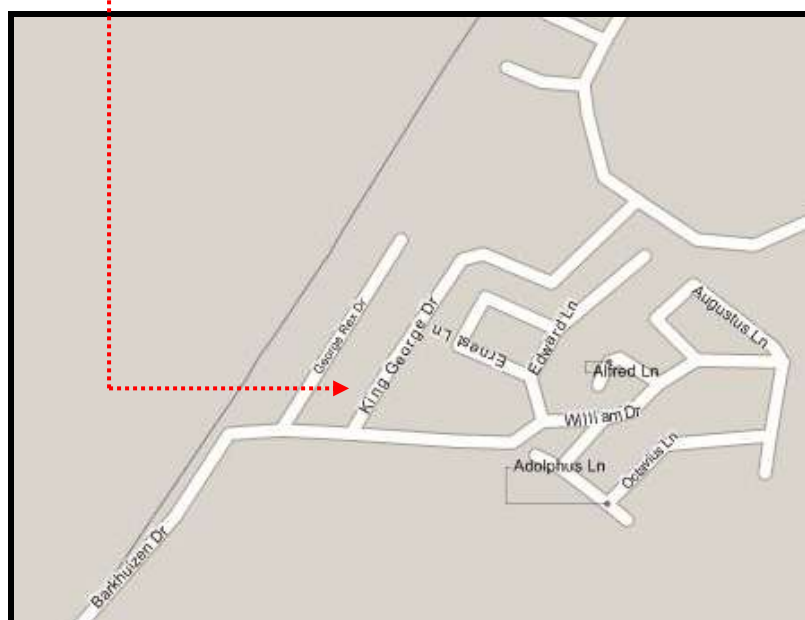

DIRECTIONS TO THE KING GEORGE PROTEA HOTEL



- Travel up Kaaimans pass
- Stay on right fork at top heading into George.
- Continue on the N12 (Knysna Rd) into George
- At traffic circle turn left into **YORK STREET**
- Turn right into **UNION STREET**
- Turn Right into **BARKHUIZEN DRIVE**
- Turn Left into **KING GEORGE DRIVE**
- Follow the signs to the Protea Hotel King George



Directions to the NMMU:

- Continue along the same roads you went on to get to the King George Protea Hotel until you begin heading out of George. (Knysna Road).
- Turn left into Saarsveld road, which is the last road on the left. On the right corner will be the Pine Lodge sign and chalets.
- Continue along Saarsveld road for 5½ km's up into the mountain until two large white pillars on the left with the sign **NMMU**.
- Continue through security gates and continue to the fields (marked in green)
